Use the "CRES. Attendance" Email Address!

Please email <u>CRES.Attendance@fivetowns.net</u> if your child is absent, will be late, or for dismissal plan messages. This email is not tied to any individual and multiple people can access it. We had one of our own in the office out sick last week and a few messages may have been missed if they were not sent to CRES.Attendance. And, as a reminder, please do not email or text your child's teacher during the day with dismissal plans. Teachers have a need to focus on students and should not be checking text or email during the instructional day. Planned Family Absence? Email Mrs. Bauer, Asst. Principal

Parents/Guardians that have a planned absence(s), for personal or educational purposes while school is in session need to notify the Assistant Principal in writing or by email in advance of the absence(s). This is a change, parents used to notify the Principal.

Procedures depending on the length of the absence:

One to twenty days:

- After approval from the Asst. Principal, the parent notifies teachers.
- Students will make up missed work when they return to school.

Over twenty days:

• For a planned absence of more than 20 consecutive days, parents are responsible for their child's education. They will need to fill out paperwork with the state to home-school their child. The student will be unenrolled from CRES for the duration of the time they are home-schooled and re-enrolled upon their return.

In rain, In snow, In sun

All students go out to recess every day at CRES, even when it's raining or cold. We go out because students benefit from movement and fresh air. They benefit from choosing activities and games they play.

Students are expected to wear the rain/cold gear their families send them to school with at each recess. CRES has extra rain jackets, pants, and boots and we have outfitted students as needed in advance. Please contact your child's teacher, or the Main Office if your child needs rain gear.

Please be sure your child has a change of clothes at school every day, in their locker or backpack. And label everything with your child's name. Thank you!


Recess Temperature Guidelines:

- If the "feels like" temperature is 0°F or higher, it is a full outside recess.
- If the "feels like" temperature is between 0° and -15°F, outdoor time is limited to 15 minutes.
- Recess will be held indoors when "feels like" temperatures are below -15°F or wind, lightning, or torrential rain make it dangerous.

Exceptions to recess participation for health reasons can be made with written parental permission.



Camden-Rockport Elementary School




